#### DUTIES

The Kent Conservation District, in cooperation with the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, is seeking an Environmental Control Technician III within the Division of Watershed Stewardship's Shellfish and Recreational Waters Program. This program is responsible for and protection of the health of primary contact swimmers and shellfish consumers.

#### REQUIREMENTS

We are seeking a dedicated and enthusiastic Environmental Control Technician III who will provide technical support to the Shellfish and Recreational Waters Program. The incumbent will be an employee of the Kent Conservation District assigned to the Delaware Division of Watershed Stewardship. This is a full-time position and The Kent Conservation District is an Equal Opportunity Employer.

This is a lead level Environmental Control Technician III; this position will be responsible for implementing rules and regulations associated with managing and regulating the protection of shellfish consumers and primary contact swimmers. As a lead worker, this position will work independently and be responsible for the day-to day coordination of assignments of technical staff and resources. The ECT will facilitate field inspections, sanitary shore line surveys and technical support in studies, surveys, inspections and research projects. This includes conducting field research and monitoring activities on properties adjacent to shellfish and recreational waters, determining pollution sources and identifying management recommendations. The incumbent will and oversee seasonal staff hired for summer field data collection. Work will also include assisting in water sample collection by boat and from shore under all weather conditions.

- Six months of experience in conducting field work to collect environmental or ecological samples and survey data.
