DUTIES

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control(DNREC), Division of Watershed Stewardship, Shoreline and Waterway Management Section is seeking an Environmental Scientist IV with a background in coastal geology to conduct research activities that support the management of Delaware's ocean and bay coastlines.

REQUIREMENTS

The Scientist will contribute to the Shoreline Management team by executing and overseeing scientific studies concerned with assessing, monitoring, quantifying, and documenting the effect of ocean and bay forces (storms, waves, currents, sea level rise, human influence, etc.) on the state's beaches and shores. The position will also assist in determining future sand sources for beach replenishment projects and in developing efficiencies and applying scientific advancements to State beach management activities.

Applicants should have direct work experience in the following areas:

- Geotechnical assessment
- Field data collection and analysis (topographic and bathymetric surveys, sediment characterization)
- GIS or coastal processes models and programs
- Possess a Master's degree or higher in an environmentally related scientific discipline
- Possess scientific prominence or recognition with publications in a scientific or trade journal.
- Three years' experience in environmental or natural resources project management which includes planning, developing, implementing, managing and evaluating environmental or natural resources projects to ensure objectives are met.
- Three years' experience in analyzing and evaluating scientific data.
